Submitting a Declaration of Candidacy Form and a Candidate’s Form 700 (see explanation below) by the posted due dates completes your process of Self-Nomination. All Declarations of Candidacy Forms and Candidate’s Form 700s must be actually received by Steele Canyon High School no later than 3:30pm August 31, 2022 (no exceptions). Hand deliver or mail the completed forms to: Steele Canyon High School, Vicki Ordway, Executive Assistant/Deputy Secretary to the Governing Board, 12440 Campo Road, Spring Valley, CA 91978-2331.

Page one – will be used to inform the community of who is running for the vacant Community Board Member positions. It will be available for public viewing and a copy will be included in the ballots. A resume may be sent in addition to, but **not** in lieu of, the Declaration of Candidacy Form. Resumes will be kept in the Election binder in the school office only for public viewing.

Page two – will be kept in a confidential file and used to certify your eligibility.

Certification:

Candidates must complete a Fair Political Practices Commission Candidate’s Form 700, Statement of Economic Interests, at the time of declaration, which is available on the fair Political Practices Commission website (www.fppc.ca.gov). Elected Board Members must also complete a Form 700 when assuming office, on an annual basis and upon leaving office.

I certify each of the following:

1. All of the information I have stated above is true.
2. I have submitted a Candidate’s Form 700, in accordance with applicable law.
3. I have read the Steele Canyon High School Charter and Bylaws.
4. I am eligible to become a candidate, in accordance with the Steele Canyon High School Charter, Bylaws, and adopted Staff Board Election Policy, and that I: a) am **EITHER** an eligible community member who resides in, or has a business within the 2006-07 historical SCHS attendance boundaries, including option areas; **OR** a parent or legal guardian of a student attending SCHS at the commencement of the terms; b) have not been convicted of a felony; c) am not an employee of SCHS, the Grossmont Union High School District (GUHSD), or vendors to SCHS or GUHSD, or “interested person” as that term is defined in Nonprofit Corporations Law; d) have the ability to attend at least 80% of regularly scheduled Board meetings and workshops and; e) have a willingness to actively support and promote the purposes and operations of the school, and a dedication to its educational philosophy and goals.
